RACE REPORT—ROUND 4

Round four, the penultimate round of the 2009 Steel Blue Road Racing season was run last Sunday (Aug 23rd) at Barbagallo Raceway. Great racing in all classes. Welcome to new riders - the Coote brothers Aiden and Mason, Cameron Elliott, Norbet Drage, Justin Scott and ex Irish racer Diarmuid Buckley

The day's first race was the 'B Grade' and Jamie Boland on the Joondalup Motorcycles Suzuki 1000 got a dream start and was never troubled during the six lap journey, Cameron Gore, Adventure Cam's Yamaha R1 was the next best followed by Kevin Boulton on the NRW CBR 1000. Shane Martin was the first C grader home with Niki Jarrett being the first 600 rider across the line. **Fastest Lap Jamie Boland 0:58.1030**

The Steel Blue Superbike Championship was a cut and thrust affair all day with all of the main players figuring in one way or another. In race one it was again Jamie Boland who showed everyone just what the back of his Suzuki looked like when he took the lead and seemed to have the race well under control, until he out braked himself at the bottom of the hill, ending up in the sand-trap, giving his hard working pit crew plenty to do between the races. Ben Stronach on the Drilling & Grouting Ducati 1098R won the race from Chris Galbraith on the Weld West Suzuki 1000 and Ben Henry on the Allect Racing Yamaha R1.

In the second race Boland on the repaired machine rode the race of his life to secure the win from Henry and Ben Stronach with Galbraith fourth and Cameron Stronach fifth.

The final race saw Henry take the win from Ben Stronach and Boland. Kev Boulton again took out the first B grader home award. **Fastest Lap Jamie Boland 0:57.4000**

The scene is now set for an exciting final round with any of the top four capable of winning.

Glen Radica on the Brandos Pizzeria Yamaha R1 has increased his lead in the 'C Grade' Superbike Championship by five points over Shane Martin and Ray Anset.

Cameron Keevers on the AARK Racing Yamaha R6 once again took the top honours in the Trak-dayz Supersport Championship and Superstock Series, continuing his unbeaten run in 2009 to twelve straight races. Josh Trigwell on the Wayne Patterson Motorcycles Yamaha R6 took the fight up to Keevers leading each of the races but was unable to sustain the pressure taking two seconds and a third place. The only other rider to stick with the front pair was Ralph Mammoliti on the Causeway Kawasaki 600 and his reward for a hard day at the office was two thirds and a second in the last race.

In the Superstock 600cc class it was Jack Coyle (Hannans Transport Suzuki) who overcame a challenge from Class leader Jason Mooney, taking two of the three race wins after a 2nd in race 1, to take out the round overall. Mooney came in 2nd overall on the day from Lubomir Safrenak, then Alan Forde and David Clarke. Coyle is now only 36 points behind Mooney for the season's finale and will need fortune on his side and Mooney to finish 3rd or worse on the day. But it is never over until the chequered flag falls.

In the Warren's Ultra Fast Karts Sidecar Championship the Walker brothers bounced back to their winning form with three convincing wins. Warren Thompson / Justin Winchester took second place with Trevor Clyma / Paul Brider grabbing third in the first race. Race two was more of the same from the Walker brothers and this time the second and third placing were reversed. The final race again saw the brothers win comfortably from Clyma / Brider but with Thompson / Winchester failing to finish Des Harvey / Kevin Webb took the minor place.

The final race of the day was the Clubman Shootout and three young riders making their debuts took the major honours. Aaiden Coote won the six lap race with his brother Mason second and Cameron Elliott took the minor placing.
